Where have you been on this day?

A Swabian crowdfunding project!

The documentary ON THIS DAY explores the memories of four global events in the 20th and early 21st centuries - Chernobyl, the Gladbeck drama, the fall of the Berlin Wall and 9/11.

Eight perspectives on four events in three decades.

Based on the mediatised testimony, the film picks out as a central theme to what extent these events shape our society today and why the subsequent events have hardly remained in our memories, although they might have been just as important.

The current handling of the media and the so-called flood of news is also being questioned, how will we deal with it in the future?

ON THIS DAY is a film project by Caroline Rosenau and Ursula Barthold. Two cinematographers, two lecturers and two generations who have been working together in the fields of film and television as well as in education since the late 90s.

Aim of the documentary

The film is aimed at everyone who remembers the four global events and those who are interested, who would like to learn more about these events and who deal with our current approach: news and media consumption. In addition, the film is aimed at all those who ask:

How will we deal with it in the future and what can we change or improve?

Film idea

If you ask people where she/ he has been on 9/11, you immediately get a response. The memories on this day are pretty clear - where they were on that day, what they did and how they felt about it.

Not only the news images burn themselves into the consciousness. On this day one clearly remembers this global impact, which shaped generations as if it happened the day before.

People felt touched even they were not directly affected by September 11th, on this day.

Current status - financing phase and support

In spring 2018, the first concept emerged from the idea, why do so many people remembers 9/11 so clearly. Since then, a treatment has been created and research work started. This resulted in a teaser and a pre-cut to a feature film (in order to be able to further develop).

ON THIS DAY is currently in the starting phase of fundraising / the so-called crowdfunding. The financing phase is planned for March.

What does crowdfunding mean?

Crowdfunding means swarm financing.

In order to continue shooting and realizing the film, the filmmakers chose the German crowdfunding provider Startnext.

Parallel to Startnext, the two filmmakers can be financially supported and promoted on their film homepage.
